



The Auditorium is located on the third floor and seats 1,080 visitors. Its luxurious and striking atmosphere never fails to impress. It is furnished with state-of-the-art equipment and provides excellent acoustics and visibility. The theater-style room is a popular venue for film previews, award ceremonies, musicals, concerts, and opening ceremonies. Each seat comes with a fold-away tray and an earphone jack that is directly connected to the built-in audio system with twelve translation booths. In addition, four rooms on the third and fourth floor of the Auditorium can be utilized for various purposes such as VIP rooms or press rooms. The Auditorium's 990m² lobby can be used for receptions, registration areas, or for auxiliary exhibitions. The eight entrances around the Auditorium allow for easy access during busy periods, and automated double swing doors make it easier to control large crowds during concerts or seminars.
